## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Ages: Club Wannago is for children entering 1st grade through entering 6th grade in the 2011-2012 year.
- Registration begins March 21, 2011.
- Early Bird Special: 50% off enrollment fee if registered by March 27, 2011.
- Registration deadline is May 22, or a \$10 late fee will be assessed in addition to the regular registration fee(s).
- Enrollment fee and all registration paperwork is due at registration; registration papers and payment is done at the Y Welcome Center. All fees and paperwork must be received 3 days before your child(ren) can participate.
- Payments options include paid-in-full by the first of each month OR weekly bank drafts. Bank drafts begin 6/17/11; complete the pink bank draft card.

## CAMP TIMES & FEES

June 8\* - August 26

Camp opens at 6:30 AM and closes at 5:45 PM, Monday through Friday. Closed July 4. \*June 8 is subject to change; camp starts the day after the Beaver Dam school district's last day of school.

**One-time registration fee: \$30/child or \$50/family max (non-refundable).**

- Minimum of 2 days attendance per week.
- All fees include transportation to/from BDUSD summer school and sports camps.
- All fees include field trips if child regularly attends 4 or more days. An additional \$15 fee per child, per field trip applies for all 2 and 3 day/week attendees.
- There is no care after summer school on field trip dates AND/OR at the Y facility on field trip dates. All participants must go on field trips or find alternative care.
- Morning and afternoon snacks are provided.
- Children must come with a sack lunch daily. Lunches must be packaged in a disposable manner (plastic silverware, paper sack, juice boxes, etc.). **No soda, gum, or candy permitted.**
- Waterbottles labeled with first letter of first name and full last name are permitted but are the child's responsibility to keep track of.
